Tuition: The applicants should confirm their participation with the School, register and pay for the course at least seven (7) days before the commencement of the course. Payment may be made directly to the School's CPD account (**Account No. 202 2029 110 Barclays Bank of Kenya, Barclays Plaza Branch, Nairobi, Kenya**) and banking slips or evidence of electronic funds transfer presented to the Finance Office. The fees quoted are inclusive of all taxes, tuition, lunch, refreshments and conference facilities. Non-East Africans pay 25% above the quoted rates.
