**ABOUT THE COURSE**

The Public Private Partnership/ Private Finance Initiatives course is designed, developed and delivered by the Kenya School of Law with a helpful input of *KO Associates*, a premier regional law firm based in Nairobi. This course on legal aspects of Public Private Partnerships provides a sharp introduction to key legal, strategic and compliance issues of PPPs/PFIs in Kenya and globally over a period of five (5) days. It is ideal for Public entities' senior management (in both National Government and Counties), regional development bodies, investors and their advisors, advocates (in-house and external), procurement officers, PPP nodes, and financiers. The course provides a clear and up to date overview of the PPP and PFI process and equips the participant with what it takes to determine whether a PPP and/or PFI fits a particular corporate strategy or government development planning. The entire PPP/PFI process is discussed in detail, the financial aspects analyzed, tax implications and the regulatory issues explored. Targeted use of real life case studies and presentations by selected regulators spice the learning experience. It is expected that those who take this course should leave ready to advise on, or oversee, the various aspects of a PPP/PFI process in Kenya.

- a) Understanding PPPs, PFIs vis-a-vis traditional Government public procurement;
- b) Effective conceptualization, development and planning of a PPPs and PFIs;

- c) Key legal considerations in designing PPP and PFI contracts;
- d) World Bank funded PPP/PFI; international procurement procedures;
- e) PPP and PFI project management;
- f) PPP/PFI contract development, administration and monitoring;
- g) The PPP/PFI project cycle;
- h) Financial and tax aspects;
- i) Legal compliance issues in PPPs and PFIs;
- j) Selected case studies.
