### CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. All interested purchasers are required to view the items and verify the details for themselves as these are not warranted by the auctioneer or the Kenya School of Law.
2. Prospective bidders will be allowed to view the items on sale upon production of original official receipt and or copy of downloaded catalogue to be certified and signed by KSL official.
3. A refundable deposit of Kshs. 2000/- must be paid to obtain a bidding number as no bidding will be allowed without the number.
4. The declared purchaser (highest bidder) must pay 25% of the purchase price in cash for the items bought at the fall of the hammer and the balance must be paid in cash within seven (7) days from the auction date failure to which the initial deposit will be forfeited and the items offered to the second bidder.
5. All items purchased and fully paid for MUST be collected within seven (7) days failure to which the purchaser shall be liable to pay a storage charge of Kshs. 500 per day.
