### **ABOUT THE COURSE**

The *Mwongozo* Code of Governance for State Corporations has been implemented in Kenya for the last 10 years. Clearly, the prescriptions in the Code are great for improving corporate governance in the public sector. In the course of implementation, and taking cognizance of emerging issues globally and locally, there are certainly issues under the Code to ponder about and seek to improve. What impact the Code has had in the past 10 years? What gaps have come to the fore that need to be addressed, to strengthen governance of public entities? How has the Code functioned within the legal environment? Are there tangible outcomes from the implementation?

The Course will interrogate these and other matters in governance and the participant will have the opportunity to get answers to questions around governance, particularly in the context of the Code.

### **COURSE CONTENT**

The course will try to answer the questions posed above, and will introduce to the participants the foundational principles to the *Mwongozo* Code of Governance and its historical context. Participants will also identify and analyse the significant milestones achieved in governance, performance and ethical conduct, as well as identify gaps and challenges since the inception of the Code.

### **INTENDED OUTCOMES**

By the end of this course the participants will be able to appreciate the principles of governance as envisioned in the Code. They will also be able to effectively develop audit programmes and checklists tailored to *Mwongozo* compliance, assess the effectiveness of their governance structures,

and examine best practices and emerging challenges in sustaining Mwongozo compliance and improving governance standards.

**CERTIFICATES:** A certificate of attendance and participation will be issued to each participant who attends the entire course.
