LAUNCH OF THE E-LEARNING PILOT PROGRAMME FOR THE 2020 ATP STUDENTS

The above matter refers.

On 16 March 2020, the School suspended learning in both the paralegal and advocates training programme (ATP) until further notice pursuant to the measures announced by the government aimed at containing the spread of the coronavirus (Covid-19). In order to mitigate the effects of those measures on learning, the School has decided to pilot an e-learning program for the ATP. From the pilot, the School will assess the viability of delivering the programme through e-learning.

This is therefore to notify all ATP students that there will be a virtual training on the e-learning platform from **Thursday 4th June to Saturday 6th June 2020 from 9.30am to 3.00 pm daily**. All students are required to register for the training through a link that is available on their emails.

The e-learning classes will commence on **Monday 8th June, 2020** and the timetable for the classes will be sent to you via email and through the respective class representatives.

Please note that even though this pilot phase will not count towards the academic year, we encourage all students to participate in the e-learning classes in order to provide the necessary feedback to allow the School to make an informed decision on the way forward.
