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**RE: RESUMPTION OF PUPILLAGE**

Following the Presidential Address on COVID -19 issued on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2020 and various government interventions aimed at mitigating the effects of the pandemic, the School after necessary consultations with relevant stakeholders, hereby lifts the suspension of pupillage communicated in its Internal Memo dated 7 April 2020. Pupils and pupil masters are thus notified that service of pupillage may resume with effect from Monday, 15 June 2020.

Students are hereby advised to resume pupillage activities, under the following terms: -

- a) The 2020 pupillage term continues from where pupils stopped as at 8 April 2020 and runs till the statutory six (6) month period is complete, that is to say, the period from 8 April – 14 June 2020 will NOT count;
- b) Pupils resuming active office attendance are required to consciously take extra caution to ensure that they remain safe;
- c) Where technology is used, the use of such technology must be seen to foster the pupillage training threshold contemplated under Section 13 of the Advocates Act, Cap 16;
- d) All pupils are expected to adhere to all government measures, directives and advisories for prevention of the spread of COVID – 19; and
- e) Pupil masters retain the discretion to extend the suspension, on an individual basis, where they feel that they are not yet in a position to resume normal operations and meet the training threshold under the Advocates Act.

To facilitate safe return to pupillage for ATP 2019 students, pupillage stations are expected to comply with all health and safety guidelines, including Ministry of Health Guidelines on COVID – 19 Prevention.
