



KENYA SCHOOL OF LAW FEES STRUCTURES

A) ADVOCATES TRAINING PROGRAMME

Students shall pay **non-refundable** fees towards their training as set forth hereunder:

1.	Tuition Fees per course unit (9 units)	15,000*
2.	Library Fees per annum	5,000
3.	Pupillage Supervision fees per annum	5,000
TOTAL		145,000

*Applicable to East-Africa nationals only. Nationals from the rest of Africa shall pay 25% more on Tuition fee, while those from outside Africa shall pay 40% more on Tuition fee.

NB: Bar Examinations fees are paid separately, details of which shall be communicated to candidates by the **Council of Legal Education (CLE)**.

B) DIPLOMA IN LAW (PARALEGAL STUDIES)

Students shall pay **non-refundable** fees towards their training as set forth hereunder:

1	Tuition Fees per course unit (Total 24 Units; 4 units per Term, Kshs. 7,500 per unit)	30,000.00
2	Examination fee per course unit (Total 24 Units; 4 examination units per term, Kshs. 3000 per unit)	12,000.00
3	Library Fees per year	5,000.00

*Applicable to East-Africa nationals only. Nationals from the rest of Africa shall pay 25% more on Tuition fee, while those from outside Africa shall pay 40% more on Tuition fee.

In addition, the following **non-refundable** fees shall be levied for other incidental services as per need:

1.	Resit Examination (per paper)	3,000.00
2.	Printing of Diploma Certificate	1,000
3.	Verification of examination script owing to wrong/missing admission no.	2,000
4.	Replacement of lost student identification card	500
