1. Third term of the 2020/2021 academic year shall begin on Monday 4th January, 2021, as scheduled
2. For the month of January, 2021, classes will continue online.
3. For the months of February and March, 2021, the School is working on modalities for implementing a blended system with a limited number of students in School for physical lectures and the others following through e-learning.
4. The School will continue to provide data bundles for students as previously done
5. Beginning January, 2021, the School lecture halls and gazebos will be open for students who wish to come and take advantage of the Wi-Fi in the School. However, all students will be required to observe social distancing and all other Covid-19 protocols while within the School compound. Students will also be required to observe the School's dress code.
6. Students will be kept updated on any new developments in due course.
