#### COURSE OVERVIEW

The Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Regulations, 2020, took effect on the **2<sup>nd</sup>, July 2020** vide Gazette Notice No. **4959** of **9<sup>th</sup> July, 2020**. The Regulations enhance the roles and responsibilities of key players in implementing the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015. This calls for ability to manage the various risks attendant to public procurement, finance and legal universe. Understanding the main categories of risk faced in the procurement and financial processes assists in risk assessment and in developing and implementing measures to mitigate those risks and comply with the applicable law.

The objective of the seminar, therefore, is to equip participant with the tools and techniques necessary to implement the Regulations and to manage financial, procurement and legal compliance risks. Specifically, the course will help the participant to:

- **Ensure** compliance with the various legal and ethical obligations under the public procurement legal environment as well as public finance management.
- **Facilitate** the establishment of appropriate strategies, policies, process and structures within their institutions.
- **Operate** with enhanced knowledge of recent developments in the field of procurement law and financial management regulations.
- **Work** with other players in relation to procurement and financial operations to ensure that they make legally sound and informed decisions, and avoid the frequent legal pitfalls.

The seminar is recommended specially for: chief executive officers/accounting officers of State corporations, educational institutions, commissions and county governments, county assembly executives and chief finance officers, Board finance committee members, directors/senior finance and procurement managers, corporation secretaries, public finance and procurement consultants/practitioners, advocates.
