The purpose of this Memo is to notify all students that the commencement date for the Pupillage program for the 2020/2021 academic year shall be 3rd May, 2021. All students are advised to process all relevant documentation and submit them to the Academic Department for the issuance of the Workbook.

The students are further advised that once the Council issues the new calendar for the bar exams, the pupillage program will be suspended for the duration of the bar exams. Accordingly, the exam dates will not be counted under the **six calendar months period** when making assessment.
