RE: MODE OF TEACHING AND ORIENTATION FOR ATP 2022 CLASS

Kindly take notice of the following updates concerning the classes commencing on 28th March, 2022;

- 1. The mode of teaching/learning will be both physical and virtual. At the point of registration, each student is required to indicate their preferred mode of learning.
- 2. Pursuant to Ministry of Health guidelines, students who opt for the physical classes will be required to produce proof of full Covid-19 vaccination on or before the 25th March, 2022.
- 3. The students who opt for the virtual classes will cater for the cost of their data bundles. The School will not buy bundles for any student.
- 4. Orientation/Director's inaugural lecture will take place on 28th March, 2022 at 10.00 am in Mutula Hall. It will also be streamed live via Teams, the link will be shared through emails provided during registration. All students are expected to be seated or logged in by 9.45 am.
- 5. Do note that the School maintains a strict dress code for all students. All students are expected to dress in official suits during orientation and while attending classes at the School.
